
Location

The GIS Day Expo will take place in the Oklahoma Memorial located near Boyd and Asp at 900 Asp Ave. in the Molly Shi Boren Ballroom.

Time

The Expo will take place from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm. Please plan on checking in between 8:30 and 9:30.

Parking

For those coming from off campus, visitor parking permits were mailed last week and we will have a few extra on hand the day of the event. While visitor permits are valid in any lot, in consultation with OU Parking and Transit they advise using lot MP 4 (aka Duck Pond lot) located off Brooks between Jenkins and Classen. 
Carts

Due to the serving capacity at the University Club and need to have booths attended we will rotate four groups of participants through at intervals which will be assigned at check in. If for any reason the time is too early or late please let one of the organizers know.



Booths and Set up

Booths are standard 6 foot tables with two chairs each with access to electricity and Wi-Fi. A diagram of booth placement is attached.

While we will have some extra equipment available, please bring items you may need such as power strips, easels, poster display supplies, etc. to set up your booth.
